Consultation on the Panel's draft report for the review of the Reliability and Emergency Reserve Trader (RERT) Guidelines

23 May 2019

The Reliability Panel (Panel) has commenced consultation on its review of the Reliability and Emergency Reserve Trader (RERT) Guidelines in accordance with clause 8.8.3 of the National Electricity Rules (Rules).

The Australian Energy Market Commission (AEMC) has issued the Panel with a terms of reference for the review of the RERT Guidelines. This terms of reference is available on the AEMC's website, www.aemc.gov.au.

The Panel has published the draft RERT Guidelines (in Appendix A of the draft report) for consultation and invites submissions from stakeholders on the amendments outlined in the draft report. Submissions should be provided to the Panel no later than **Thursday**, **20 June 2019**.

All submissions that do not contain confidential information will be published on the AEMC website.
