
Formal commencement of claim

The Australian Energy Market Commission (AEMC) gives notice under the National Electricity Rules as follows:

On 21 June 2022, the AEMC received notification of a claim for compensation under clause 3.14.6 from Braemar Power Project Pty Ltd following the application of the administered price cap during an administered price period in Queensland, New South Wales and Victoria between 12 June 2022 and 15 June 2022.

Braemar Power Project Pty Ltd is claiming compensation for direct costs only, incurred in operating Braemar Power Station units 2 and 3 during the administered price period.

Braemar Power Project Pty Ltd provided information in support of its claim on 3 August 2022 and 6 September 2022.

The AEMC is reasonably satisfied that it has sufficient information from Braemar Power Project Pty Ltd to assess the claim and has now commenced formal assessment of the claim. The timeframes provided in clauses 3.14.6(I) to (s) of the National Electricity Rules will now apply to this claim for compensation.
