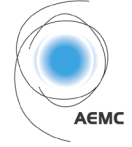


Notice under National Electricity Law

Notice of Initiation of Rule Change Request



The Australian Energy Market Commission (AEMC) gives notice under the National Electricity Law as follows:

Under s 95, The Honourable Chris Bowen MP, Minister for Climate Change and Energy on behalf of the Commonwealth Government has requested the *Accommodating financeability in the regulatory framework* (Ref. ERC0348) and *Concessional Finance for Transmission Network Services Providers* (Ref. ERC0349) proposals.

The ERC0348 proposal seeks to address the foreseeable risk that financeability challenges could arise for actionable ISP projects, which may impact the timely and efficient delivery of these projects.

The ERC0349 proposal seeks to change the NER to include an approach to determining how the financial benefits that arise from concessional financing of transmission infrastructure are shared between consumers and Transmission Network Service Providers.

Submissions must be received by **14 July 2023**.
