Exemption application – Kambalda to Esperance Gas Pipeline (PL 59 & PL 98)

Your application for an exemption under Part 23 of the *National Gas Rules*, as applied in Western Australia, for the Kambalda to Esperance Gas Pipeline (PL 59 & PL 98) has been assessed by the Economic Regulation Authority (ERA).

The ERA has decided to grant Category 1 and 2 exemptions for the Kambalda to Esperance Gas Pipeline, subject to condition. The exemptions are valid from 9 May 2023 to 30 June 2028.

Kambalda to Esperance Gas Pipeline is exempt from the operation of Division 3 and Division 4 as well as the obligation to publish information under Division 2 of Part 23 of the *National Gas Rules (WA)*.

However, Esperance Pipeline Co. Pty Limited as service provider for the Kambalda to Esperance Gas Pipeline (PL 59 & PL 98) must report to the ERA on the status of the pipeline, including any new owner, operator and user, by 31 December 2023 and every year thereafter. Failure to comply with this obligation could result in the ERA revoking the exemptions granted.

Also, these exemptions may be varied or revoked at any time, in accordance with provisions in the *National Gas Rules (WA)*.

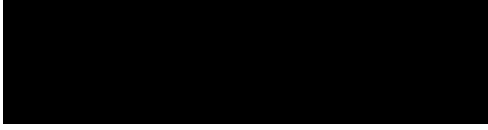
Esperance Pipeline Co. Pty Limited must still comply with all other provisions in the *National Gas Rules (WA)* not covered by these exemptions.

As required under Rule 585(8) of the *National Gas Rules (WA)*, please notify the ERA without delay if circumstances change such that the pipeline no longer qualifies for the exemption granted.

The ERA is required to establish, publish and maintain a register of exemptions. Your application will be published on the ERA's [website](#).
