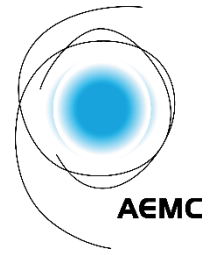


Formal commencement of claim

The Australian Energy Market Commission (AEMC) gives notice under the National Electricity Rules (NER) as follows:

On 22 June 2022, the AEMC received notification of a claim for compensation under clause 3.14.6 from Origin Energy Electricity Limited following in application of the administered price cap during an administered price period in Queensland, New South Wales, South Australia, and Victoria between 12 June 2022 and 15 June 2022.

Origin Energy Electricity Limited is claiming compensation for opportunity costs only incurred in operating Uranquinty Power Station Units 11-14 (NSW), Quarantine Power Station Unit 5 (South Australia), and Mortlake Power Station Units 11 and 12 (Victoria) during the administered price period. As a result, the claim is not a direct cost only claim.

Origin Energy Electricity Limited provided initial information in support of its claim on 6 September 2023.

The AEMC is reasonably satisfied that it has sufficient information from Origin Energy Electricity Limited to assess the claim and has now commenced formal assessment of the claim. The timeframe provided in clauses 3.14.6 (o) to (u) of the NER will apply to this claim for compensation.
