Submission on Transmission Access Reform – Consultation Paper

Enel Green Power Australia (EGPA) is one of Australia's leading renewable energy developers. We welcome the opportunity to provide a submission on the *Transmission Access Reform Consultation Paper*.

Renewable energy is critical to Australia's energy transition, economy development and climate change actions. Having a stable policy framework that incentivises investment in renewable energy is key to achieve Australia's renewable energy target.

While we understand the intent behind the proposed Priority Access Model in the Transmission Access Reform Consultation Paper, we are concerned it may inadvertently deter new investments in renewable energy outside of Renewable Energy Zones (REZs). This could potentially delay the achievement of Australia's renewable energy target of reaching 82% renewable energy by 2030, subsequently disrupting the overall transition to a renewable energy future.

EGPA has commissioned Baringa Partners to conduct an independent review of the proposed reforms. We have attached the review report for AEMC's consideration and publication.
