Re: Category 2 Part 10 exemption - Nowra gas distribution network

I refer to your letter dated 30 January 2024 for a Category 2 revocation application under Part 10 of the National Gas Rules (NGR) for the Nowra gas distribution network.

After assessment, the AER is **not satisfied** that Nowra gas distribution network meets the criteria for a Category 2 exemption under Part 10 of the NGR. The reasons are as follows¹:

- Nowra gas distribution network is not a single user pipeline as defined under the NGR².
- Nowra gas distribution network is a distribution pipeline with a maximum daily capacity of more than 10 TJ/day.

Thereby, the AER has determined to revoke Nowra gas distribution network's Category 2 exemption under Part 10 of the NGR.³

This revocation is in effect from the date of this letter, i.e., 25 March 2024. Evoenergy may apply to the AER for a new exemption if circumstances change such that the pipeline meets one or more exemption criteria.

Rule 102(6) requires the AER to maintain a public register of Part 10 exemptions. Barring personal information, details in your submitted revocation application may be published on the register along with this response.
