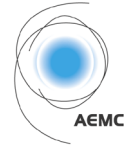


Notice under National Electricity Law



Notice of initiation

The Australian Energy Market Commission (AEMC) gives notice under the National Electricity Law as follows:

Under s 95, The Hon Tom Koutsantonis MP, Minister for Energy and Mining in South Australia has requested the *South Australian jurisdictional derogation – Interim reliability reserve eligibility* (Ref. ERC0407) proposal. The proposal seeks a jurisdictional derogation in South Australia to allow the Australian Energy Market Operator (AEMO) to consider additional plant for out-of-market reserves. The AEMC intends to expedite the proposal under s 96 as it considers the proposed Rule is urgent, subject to requests not to do so. Written requests not to expedite the proposal must be received by **12 December 2024**. Submissions must be received by **2 January 2025**.
