

National Electricity Amendment (South Australian jurisdictional derogation - Interim reliability reserve eligibility) Rule 2025 No. 1

The Australian Energy Market Commission makes the following Rule under the National Electricity Law to the extent applied by:

- (a) the *National Electricity (South Australia) Act 1996* of South Australia;
- (b) the *Electricity (National Scheme) Act 1997* of the Australian Capital Territory;
- (c) the *Electricity National Scheme (Queensland) Act 1997* of Queensland;
- (d) the *National Electricity (New South Wales) Act 1997* of New South Wales;
- (e) the *Electricity National Scheme (Tasmania) Act 1999* of Tasmania;
- (f) the National Electricity (Victoria) Act 2005 of Victoria;
- (g) the National Electricity (Northern Territory) (National Uniform Legislation) Act 2015 of the Northern Territory; and
- (h) the Australian Energy Market Act 2004 of the Commonwealth.

1 Title of Rule

This Rule is the *National Electricity Amendment (South Australian jurisdictional derogation - Interim reliability reserve eligibility) Rule 2025 No. 1.*

2 Commencement

This Rule commences operation on 23 January 2025.

3 Amendment to the National Electricity Rules

The National Electricity Rules are amended as set out in Schedule 1.

Schedule 1 Amendment to the National Electricity Rules

(Clause 3)

[1] Rule 9.27 Interim reliability reserve eligibility for the South Australian region

Omit rule 9.27 including the heading and substitute:

9.27 Interim reliability reserve eligibility for the South Australian region

9.27.1 Definitions

In this rule 9.27:

interim reliability reserves has the meaning given in clause 11.128.1.

9.27.2 Expiry date

This rule 9.27 expires on 31 March 2025.

9.27.3 Interim reliability reserve eligibility

- (a) Clause 3.20.3(g) does not apply to prevent *AEMO* from negotiating or entering into a *reserve contract* for interim reliability reserves in relation to the capacity of the *generating units* specified in the following table.
- (b) Clause 3.20.3(h) does not apply to prevent a person from negotiating or entering into a *reserve contract* for interim reliability reserves in relation to the capacity of the *generating units* specified in the following table.
- (c) For the avoidance of doubt, any requirement of the *RERT guidelines* corresponding to the requirements of clause 3.20.3(g) or (h) does not apply to prevent *AEMO* from negotiating or entering into a *reserve* contract for interim reliability reserves in relation to the capacity of the *generating units* specified in the following table.
