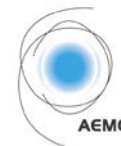


Notice under National Electricity Law



The Australian Energy Market Commission (AEMC) gives notice under the National Electricity Law of the following matters.

Under section 95, AEMO has requested the *Small Generation Aggregator Framework Rule* proposal (Project Ref. ERC0141). The proposal seeks to create a new type of market participant called a Small Generation Aggregator to facilitate participation of small generators in the National Electricity Market through lower administration costs. Submissions must be received by **12 April 2012**.

Under sections 102 and 103, the making of the *National Electricity Amendment (Expiry of Reliability and Emergency Reserve Trader) Rule 2012 No. 1* and related final determination. Schedule 1 commences on **15 March 2012**, and Schedules 2 and 3 commences on **1 July 2016**.

Under section 107, the period of time for the making of the draft determination on the *New Prudential Standard and Framework in the NEM* Rule proposal has been extended to **12 April 2012**.

Under section 107, the period of time for the making of the final determination on the *Negative intra-regional settlements residue* Rule proposal has been extended to **22 March 2012**.

Submissions can be lodged online via the AEMC's website at www.aemc.gov.au. Before lodging your submission, you must review the AEMC's privacy statement on its website. Submissions should be made in accordance with the *AEMC's Guidelines for making written submissions on Rule change proposals*. The AEMC publishes all submissions on its website subject to confidentiality.
