


Notice under National Electricity Law



The Australian Energy Market Commission (AEMC) gives notice under the National Electricity Law as follows:

Under s 95, COAG Energy Council has requested the *Governance Arrangements and Implementation of the Reliability and Settings* proposal (Ref. ERC0160). The proposal seeks to modify the National Electricity Rules to require the AEMC to determine the reliability standard and reliability settings, and to develop related guidelines. The rule change request also proposes to make the Australian Energy Market Operator responsible for all reliability operational decisions and to develop processes to assess the adequacy of generation reserves to meet the reliability standard, and to develop related guidelines. Submissions must be received by **23 October 2014**.

Submissions can be made via the AEMC's website. Before making a submission, please review the AEMC's privacy statement on its website. Submissions should be made in accordance with the AEMC's *guidelines for making written submissions on Rule change proposals*. The AEMC publishes all submissions on its website, subject to confidentiality.
