Consultation on the Panel's review of the frequency operating standards for Tasmania

- the proponents of new generating projects can identify the changes to the standards that would be necessary if their proposed generating units were connected; and
- stakeholders can identify relevant and important economic factors that the Panel should consider when assessing any changes to the standards.

The Panel will hold a Stakeholder forum to provide an opportunity for comments and questions on Friday, 6 June 2008 at 10.00 AM in Hobart.
